If you have any questions and there is a need to call a Board Member to answer your inquiry, please contact the Club Office between 12:00 PM & 6:00 PM or the Director of Skating, Patrick O’Neil, between 8:00 AM & 2:00 PM to leave a message for them.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY !!

Fall / Winter	August 25th through February 28th
ROI	March 2nd through April 5th (Show 4/2-4/5 tentative)
Spring	April 8th through June 13th

December 24-January 1 is not included in the 35 weeks and will run as a separate mini contract called “Holiday Ice Contract.”

The F/W/S Contract is one contract for 37 weeks.
ROI is a separate contract for 5 weeks.

There are several times during the skating season where there will be NO ICE or OFF ICE.

These particular days will not be included in your contract. The club will compute your contract for you and mail your statement to you. It is your responsibility to have your payment in to the Club Office on or before the 15th of every month. PLEASE READ PAGE 5 CAREFULLY!!

CONTRACT REGISTRATION

Enclosed is the FALL / WINTER/SPRING Schedule for the St. Clair Shores Figure Skating Club. **The FALL / WINTER/SPRING Contract will be accepted in person by seniority date located at the back of this contract book.**

The deadline for scheduling all contracted ice time is August 14, 2008 at 6:00pm. After this date, contracts of current Members will be accepted with a \$25 late fee. If you have any questions regarding the contract or registration, please direct them to Fran Rinaldi, or Patrick O'Neil @ 586.774.7530.

IMPORTANT!!!

Before any contract is submitted, you must make sure your account is not in arrears.

Any Member not in good standing may not take out a new contract.

If you have any questions, please contact the Club to clear the matter from our records prior to scheduling your ice time.

Registration and Payment Procedures:

CHOOSE YOUR ICE CAREFULLY. The ice you contract is yours for the full season. It is your financial responsibility to maintain prompt payments and to pay your contract in full. Payments are due on or before the 15th of every month.

Registration Procedure:

- 1) **Choose a Package**
- 2) **Mark the desired sessions CLEARLY!!**
- 3) **Contracts require service hour fee of \$100 and \$75.00 deposit at time of registration.**
Balance of F/W/S in 10 equal payments is due on or before the 15th of each month. Your payment schedule is as follows: September 15, October 15, November 15, December 15, January 15, February 15, March 15, April 15, May 15th, June 15th. June 15th is your 10th payment on the F/W/S Contract.
- 4) **The total balance due to register will be \$175.00. This includes service hour fee of \$100.00 and \$75.00 deposit towards your contracted ice. *(\$250.00 for those not completing 2006-2007 service hours.)**

All contracts less than \$150.00 must be paid in full at time of registration.

PLEASE PLAN TO SUBMIT TWO SEPARATE CHECKS (ONE FOR SERVICE HOURS;ONE FOR DEPOSIT)

Make checks payable to : St. Clair Shores Figure Skating Club (SCSFSC)

For your convenience, we now accept Visa and Mastercard on your contracts. Payments can be made in the office only. No phone payments can be accepted. Please plan accordingly.

- 5) **Please calculate your total amount and know what your monthly payment will be.**

LATE PAYMENTS:

Any skater making their payment after the 15th of the month will be charged a \$35.00 late fee.

Anyone not paid by the 15th will also be denied ice time, test sessions and competition privileges.

If the 15th falls on a Sunday or a holiday, please plan to have the payment in on the Friday before that Sunday or holiday. It is our obligation to report any delinquent skaters to other Detroit Metro Council members to inform them of your arrears. For your benefit, please be prompt with your payments. Also for your benefit, calculate the total amount of your contract and know what your monthly payment is.

It is your responsibility to know when the office is opened and closed. This is important for those of you needing to make credit card or cash payments.

NSF (BOUNCED CHECK):

Member will be notified and a new check must be submitted within 7 days of notification.

If second check is declared **NSF** on skater's account the following procedure will be implemented:

Member will be notified.

New payment must be received within 7 days of notification.

New payment must be made in **cash, money order or certified check**.

Only cash, money orders or certified checks will be accepted on the account for a period of 12 months, following the second infraction.

A check received from someone else to pay your account is **not** acceptable.

No checks other than **CERTIFIED** will be allowed.

SERVICE HOURS:

During our Fall/Winter/Spring and Summer Sessions, SCSFSC contracted 1st club members are required to work or pay a service hour fee. This requirement must be met by August 1, 2007. If you need further information regarding service hours, please contact Fran Rinaldi, or email her at **SCSFSC1@aol.com**. At time of registration \$100.00 service hour fee is due from **all** 1st Club Members.

\$250.00 FOR THOSE NOT COMPLETING 2006-2007 SERVICE HOURS - PLUS \$100 (CURRENT YEAR) TOTAL DUE \$350.00.

Service Hours must be turned in within 14 days of the event or credit will not be given.

MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS:

Three General Membership Meetings are held each year for your voice and are open to all members. Meetings will be held October 22, January 21, and May 12. Please attend and get involved, this is your Club.

ICE SHOW:

April 2nd through April 5 (TENTATIVE)

The 2009 Reflections On Ice Show is scheduled for Spring, 2009. Soloists must be a 1st club member for 12 months prior to ice show sign up. All members are encouraged to participate in Reflections On Ice. Second club members are welcome to participate, but will not have a solo number. Further information on Reflections On Ice will be announced at a later date. Cutoff for solo & level requirements is October 1, 2007. Any test **after** this date will **not** be recognized to determine level or solo status

EXCEPTION made for all EGL competitors (non-qualifying and qualifying). Those athletes who compete at EGL 2008 may test in October and use that test level for the Ice Show provided they have competed and signed up for the show by the deadline prior to October Test Session

A reminder that you must contract and skate a minimum of 3 on ice sessions per week during the F/W/S Contract in order to participate in Reflections on Ice. This includes contracting and skating a minimum of 3 sessions during the ROI contract.

CONTRACT ICE SESSION REQUIREMENTS:

Basic, Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior, and Senior. **In order to choose your level of skating, you must have passed the Freestyle for which you are contracting.**

EXAMPLE: Juv - Int

You must have passed your Juvenile or Intermediate Freestyle test.

REMINDER: - A basic skater is any skater working on Alpha through Pre-Preliminary Freestyle, who has not passed the Pre-Preliminary Freestyle.

ON ICE SESSIONS

Dance Sessions and Four levels of Freestyle (FS)

Training Sessions (TS)

On-ice training offered for the development, power, strength, aerobic and anaerobic conditioning, directed by a coach (coach's fee included).

Field Moves Sessions (FM): Offered 6 days a week for practice of moves in the field; private lessons

contracted with the professional of your choice.

* *Open Field Move Session:* (OFM) Open to all skaters taking Field Moves.

* *High Field Move Session:* (HFM) Skaters who **HAVE PASSED** Intermediate

Field Move Test and above.

Open Sessions (Open): This session will be open to all skating levels and all disciplines.

OFF ICE SESSIONS:

Resistance Training (RT):

Specific muscle training with resistance, or weights, plyometrics, balance exercises, aerobic workouts and stretching.

*Proper attire: gym clothes and gym shoes.

Ballet: Designed to gain knowledge of correct body alignment and placement and to improve coordination of the body with musicality and rhythmic accuracy.

*Proper attire: (Female) skating dress or leotard and tights, hair pulled away from face & ballet slippers.

(Male) spandex shorts, T-shirt tucked in, white short socks and black ballet slippers.

Stretch: This is a 30 minute class working on releasing and lengthening overworked muscles, to keep the muscles and joints healthy and flexible.

*Proper attire: Any warm sweatshirt and pants and a stretch mat.

Pilates: This is a conditioning class that teaches you about breathing with movement, body mechanics, balance, co-ordination, positioning of the body, spatial awareness and strength and flexibility.

Yoga: This class will consist of gentle stretching, breathing, and learning the art of focus and concentration.

Conditioning Class: This class will emphasize aerobic, and aerobic agility, balance, core strengthening, and power. No weight training will be done. An excellent class for the skater who hasn't tried RT yet or for the experienced skating athlete who wishes to supplement their off-ice program.

ICE FEES:

The Fall/Winter/Spring 2008-2009 pricing will done by packages listed below. The more ice you take, the cheaper your session rate is. Please choose the package that best suits your needs. If, for example, you are not a Synchronized Skater but that package best fits what you are looking for, then please take that package. You can choose any combination of on ice sessions you want that match the package you are taking.

Training Sessions are \$4.25

Training Sessions are purchased separately and are not included in the number of sessions skated in the package.

Please Read

- The SCSFSC shall not be liable for any and all claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses of any kind to persons or property, which may be sustained in connection with any SCSFSC activity.
- Recognizing the normal risk of skating on ice, I agree to skate at my own risk and to abide by all skating regulations established by the St. Clair Shores Figure Skating Club, the Arena management and/or professionals. The St. Clair Shores Figure Skating Club assumes no responsibility for accidents on or off the ice, or damage to personal property.
- In the event an emergency situation arises, in which I/we are unable to be contacted or are unavailable for immediate authorization, I/we give permission to, or if unavailable, to the SCSFSC, to arrange for emergency procedures for the contracted skater at a local hospital, or by a physician, and agree to hold all parties harmless.
- The SCSFSC ice contract, may not be transferred, bartered, or sold and is to be used exclusively by the contracted skater for an activity of equal, but not greater value, in On Ice or Off Ice activity.
- The SCSFSC reserves the right to cancel scheduled events without liability, other than reimbursement.
- The SCSFSC is not responsible for lost, late, stolen or misdirected mail.
- The SCSFSC is not responsible for typographical errors.
- SCSFSC requires that ice contract payments be RECEIVED in the club office NOT POSTMARKED by the specified date in your ice contract. NO POSTDATED CHECKS. All late payments are assessed a \$35.00 late fee, and the affected skater shall be denied on and off ice privileges and the opportunity to test and compete, until their account is brought current with payment of the late charges and contract payments.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CONTRACTED SESSIONS.

NO MEDICAL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.

YOU CANNOT MAKE UP SESSIONS YOU MISS.

SCSFSC SKATERS POLICIES:

- 1. **Skaters must sign in with the monitor before taking the ice for the day.**
- 2. **If you are not planning to skate a contracted session, please notify the monitor so someone else may use it.**
- 3. **Sessions will be sold after 5 minutes, EXCEPTION: those skaters whose names have been recorded as having to arrive late.**
- 4. **Absolutely no eating, drinking or gum chewing on the ice.**
- 5. **Proper respect must be shown to all Professionals, ice and music monitors at all times by the skaters and parents.**
- 6. **Do not interrupt Professionals while they are in a lesson.**
- 7. **SKATERS IN A LESSON HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. COACHES USING THE HARNESS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR SAFETY REASONS.**
- 8. **No foul language or show of temper while on the ice or at any time while representing our club.**
- 9. **Kicking holes in the ice is inexcusable and you will be asked to leave the ice.**
- 10. **All skaters are asked to leave the ice immediately when the zamboni driver sounds the buzzer.**
- 11. **No radios or cassette players will be allowed on the ice, excluding Professionals.**
- 12. **Dressing rooms and other areas around the arenas are to be left clean and all debris picked up and put in trash containers. GIRLS AND BOYS MAY NOT BE IN EACH OTHERS LOCKER ROOMS FOR ANY REASON.**
- 13. **NO EQUIPMENT OR CHANGING IN THE CONCESSION AREA. USE THE DRESSING ROOMS.**
- 14. **The pro staff room, the club office, directors office and the tape booths are for club business only. Skaters and parents are allowed only if they are conducting business.**
- 15. **Ice is for skating, no visiting. If you must visit, please leave the ice.**
- 16. **Proper skating attire is highly requested, skating dresses are preferred for the ladies. Skating dresses for the girls, form fitting pants for the boys. No street clothes.**

ALL MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES WITH CLASS AND DIGNITY. BAD MOUTHING MEMBERS, PROFESSIONAL STAFF, BOARD MEMBERS OR CITY EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

MEMBERS WHO CANNOT ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE ICE AND/OR THE BUILDING. NAMES WILL BE RECORDED AND PARENTS CALLED IF NECESSARY. REPEATED OR SERIOUS INFRACTIONS OF THE RULES WILL BE REFERRED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S AND LOSS OF ICE PRIVILEGES AND/OR MEMBERSHIP MAY ENSUE. THE SCSFSC BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE/CANCEL/DENY ANY MEMBERSHIP OF THOSE INDIVIDUALS (or Potential Members) WHO BLATANTLY IGNORE THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ABOVE.
